Start process no later than 4-6 months before the start of your program

Eligibility & Requirements

General Eligibility

- Must be in good academic & disciplinary standing
- Must be a full-time student
- Must have completed two full-time semesters (24 hours) by the start of their program

Exchange

- Must have 3.000 GPA at the time of application
- Must stay at host university of entity of the semester, including exams
- Can not take place in your last two semesters at UTD
- Must have identified approved business classes that will transfer to UTD

International Education Fund (IEF) Scholarship

- Applicants must have a UTD cumulative grade point average of at least 2.75.
- Award range: \$500-\$5000
- Deadlines: March 15 for fall programs, **October 15** for spring programs, **December 15** for summer programs

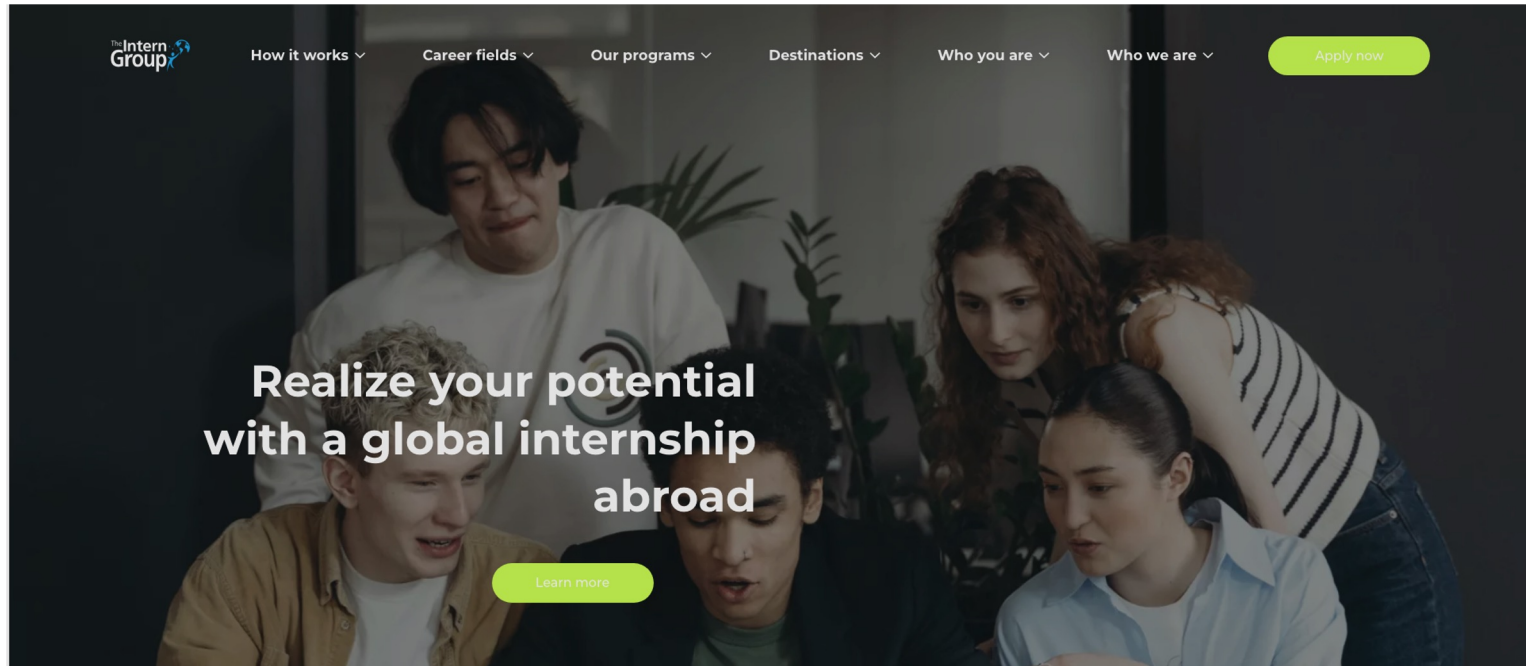

Proactive for Tracking Course Transfer

Be Aware of Cultural Differences

**The University of Texas at Dallas
Foreign Course Articulation Form (FCAF)**

Instructions:

1. Student meets with academic advisor to review degree plan requirements.
2. Student completes top section and section I by filling in Courses to be taken abroad.
3. Student submits FCAF and course syllabi to appropriate teaching unit for review (see page 3).
4. Teaching unit reviews course(s) and determines UTD course equivalent in section II. Teaching unit signs next to each articulated course and determines approval type (one-time or standing) in section III.
5. Student meets with academic advisor to discuss how articulated courses fit within degree plan. Academic advisor signs in bottom section IV.
6. Student submits completed and signed form to Education Abroad (educationabroad@utdallas.edu).

Ask For Help

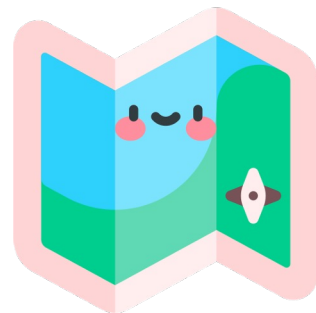
